### How Will I Know? Eastertide Worship at First on Fifth

"The Lord is risen! He is risen indeed!" These words of joy rang out this Easter morning, triumphant with the possibility of transformation. But as lilies fade and trumpets quiet, the living-out of resurrection's hope becomes trickier. Looking for the risen Christ can leave us wondering, "how will I know resurrection?" The existential wondering of "how will I know" applies indiscriminately to everything: how will I know love, how will I know belonging, how will I know forgiveness, and the many that follow. This Eastertide, we listen to the stories of Jesus's encounters on this side of resurrection to seek an answer, and we'll find along the way that the risen Jesus is known now as he was known then: by the way, the mark, the meal, the voice, the love.
